Following up on the no cost rides, many older adults are faced with increased medical expenses, burdening their fixed monthly income. Transportation expenses are additional burden. STS prides itself in providing all clients the same level of service no matter what level of income. Low-income clients receive free transportation to ensure they receive the medical services they require. Every quarter, STS would like to include our Ride Reports in our Newsletter to show exactly how much free transportation we are able to provide through the donations, grants and sponsorships we receive!

Free Ride Totals October-December 2023:

Total number of free rides provided in the communities: 913 free rides!

Total number of rides provided in all 6 communities: 1,214 rides!
